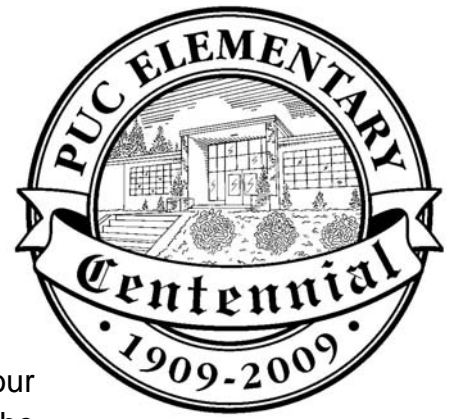


PUCE Weekly News
