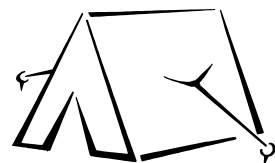


# 2007 PUCE Beach Campout at Bodega Dunes

Friday – Sunday, Sept. 7-9



**Campground:** Sonoma Coast State Beaches—Bodega Dunes Campground is located just north of Bodega Bay on Highway 1. The campsites are tent-type campsites for up to 8 people per campsite. There is a charge of \$4.00 - \$6.00 for the second car at each site. The campground has good bathroom facilities and showers. All **pets must be on a leash** at all times in the campground and on the beach and are not allowed in the sand dunes at all.

**Parking:** **Campers**, please leave your car at your campsite, parked off the road and either walk or take a PUCE Shuttle to the beach after the morning program.

**Day visitors**, please park at the beach parking lot—turn right after the check-in kiosk. (Unless the ranger there allows you to use the overflow parking lot within the campground.) The beach parking lot is about one mile from the check-in kiosk. PUCE Shuttles will be available to transport you from parking to the Campfire Center for the morning program and/or back to the beach afterward.

**Meals:** If you did not sign up for a meal ahead of time and would like to partake, you are welcome to do so as long as it seems there is plenty of food. Pay Lisa on Monday. \$3.50/meal per person.

## Itinerary: **FRIDAY:**

2:00 p.m. Check-in begins. Campers select their site when they arrive. Try first for a spot on the upper loop as it is close the campfire bowl.

6:00 p.m. Supper in the campground at site #6

**Menu:** Pasta, salad and bread

7:30 p.m. Campfire program featuring **Jon Thornton** with coco and s'mores!

## **SATURDAY:**

10:30 a.m. Worship service in the campfire bowl featuring **Bob Paulson** and a skit entitled "In Whose Hands" performed by **6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> graders**.

12:30 a.m. Lunch at the picnic area next to the beach and adjacent to the parking lot.

**Menu:** Haystacks

2:00 p.m. Fun on the beach—scriptural sand sculpting, dune sliding, ball, kite flying, etc.

*(Note: Northern California beaches are very dangerous due to rip tides and sleeper waves. Either do not go in the water or WATCH your children and the waves very closely.)*


6:00 p.m. Supper back at the campground

7:30 p.m. Campfire program! Bob Paulson hosts the PUCE Talent Show showcasing the surprising and unexpected talents of our students and families plus coco and s'mores.
